

Objectives of this hostel for Blind brothers who needed support those who finds difficult to meet their cost of basic needs like house rent, food expenses are given admission..
- All these people are self-employed by selling pass covers, diaries and cutlery items at local railway, express railway, platforms etc, some of them are massage provider..
- Our Vision To provide opportunity for self-employment, better living conditions, healthy and happy life to the destitute blind brothers of the society.

Project Information & Its Impact

Working Men's Hostel (For Blind And Handicapped People

This is a residential Project started for the blind and Handicap brothers. A total of 12 visual impaired brothers are living in this hostel. All are underprivilege. The responsibility of all these has been accepted through our organization and all the facilities are provided to them here. A one-story bungalow has been taken on lease basis for hostel through the institution. All facilities for stay and accommodation such as double bed, mattress, sheet bed given along with CCTV cameras security. Nutritious breakfast Tea and Dinner are provided.

Project Objective

- To provide shelter to blind and disabled people
- To provide necessary vocational and other forms of training for self-reliance

Impact

- Since the project was started, 12 blind and disabled brothers is staying here.
- They completed training in commercial production and sales skills.
- Today, problem of their basic needs is solved and they are selling their own manufactured goods.

Why We Focus On Blind & disabled?

- Blind and disabled people neglected by society who really need help but are struggling to survive. Brothers who bravely overcome physical hardships on a regular basis.
- They don't have much choice but to depend on others for basic needs.

Problems faced by Blind & disabled ...

- No one spend enough time with Blind & disabled due to the nature of their work
- They did not receive guidance on their creative skills and thus these skills were often neglected by Normal people
- Due to not being financially capable, education is barely available.
 They required capital for professional and for education and for business. They always fear security from others in the society.
- Without guidance on manners, good habits, and constructive selfdevelopment, blinds find it difficult to navigate social life and relationships.

Working Hostel

Need of this project-

Due to rising inflation and rising house rents in Mumbai and Thane cities, blind and disabled people find it very difficult to earn a living in these places. Physically weaker sections are neglected in the fast forward dynamic era of society. To solve this, we are providing the facility of Men's Working Hostel through our organization in the village of Vangani in Ambernath Taluka of Thane district, Maharashtra.

Purpose of Project-

NATIONAL FEDERATION OF VISUAL IMPAIRED PERSONS social organization has been working for the economically weaker and baseless blind and disabled people of Mumbai and thane cities. Blind and disabled people in the society live independently and with dignity and self-employment without depending on others, without expecting help from others. They should get a safe, stable and rightful home. Facilitate nutrition and physical examination for good health. To enable visually impaired individuals to overcome the barriers that impede their independence and participation in society.
